Dear Go players between Rhine and Maas,

the table is getting shape now. In the fourth round, Köln regained the leading position. The former leading team Liège is close behind, suffering from having played one game less. The fifth round is a single one for Köln, so Liège will have the chance to catch up. We are very interested whether they will succeed or not. At least both teams are the clear candidates for the Ten-Year-Anniversary-Rhein-Maas-Liga-Champion, although Bonn Uni still has some chances.

There is one point I would like to discuss, concerning the future of the RML-Post. In the first issues, I asked for match reports, pictures and anything else to help me produce a living RML-Post. Upon my special request, Arend wrote a nice report from one round in Aachen. Beyond that the resonance was simply zero. Hence I must conclude that the interest in a regular RML-Post is pretty low, if existent at all.

It takes about one complete day to compile an issue, from writing the foreword over thinking how to fill all the empty pages up to copying and folding finally. Therefore I am asking myself whether it makes sense to continue the RML-Post is the current way or to switch over to another way of organizing the RML.

The results of all single games in detail are available from the WWW already now. We could replace the time consuming RML-Post by an email list for the results which everybody would be invited to join. To ensure that nobody will be excluded, the time schedule would be pro-

duced in the classical paper form at the beginning of the year. I assume that this procedure also allows a smooth RML organization.

I would appreciate to hear your opinion about this.

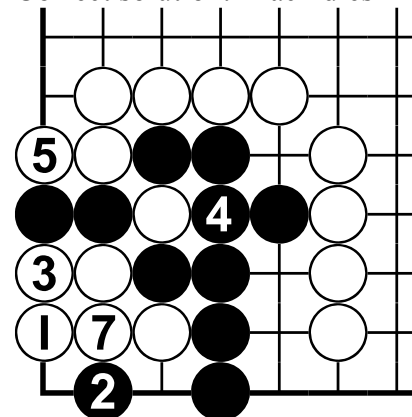

Go problem

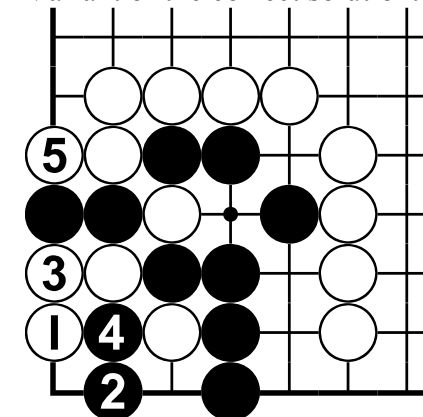
Solution of the Go problem from the previous issue:

Correct solution: Black dies



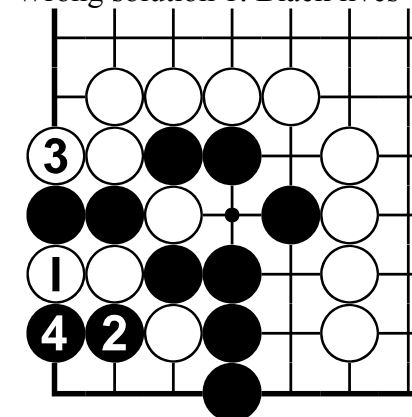
6: connects

Variant of the correct solution:



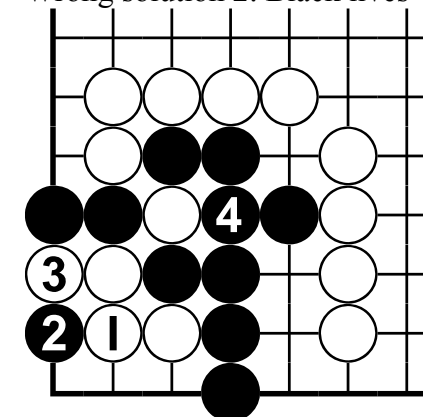
Black is left with one eye.
