CCTV World Youth Amateur On-line Weiqi Tournament Supplementary Notice

I. Competition Methods:

- Time allowance : The time allowance is 60 minutes per player, followed by 30 seconds byoyomi for 5 times. Being late by more than 15 minutes in each round shall be declared to have forfeited the game.
- 2. The competition shall be divided into two groups according to age, among which the children's group shall be the individual competition and the youth group shall be the team competition. The order of the player in youth group must be determined. Once the order is confirmed, it cannot be changed.
- The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest rules enacted by the Chinese Weiqi Association. All games to be played on even, with Black giving a 7 ¹/₂ komi.
- 4. Determination of which side plays first:
 - a) Children group: It is determined according to the arrangement results;
 - b) Youth group: According to the results of the arrangement, the first and the third of the teams on the left side play with black, while the second of the team play with white; the first and the third on the right side play with white and the second of the team play with black.
- 5. The number of players is decided by computer drawing lots.
- 6. Scoring method:

- a) Children group: 2 points for winning and 0 point for losing.
- b) Youth group: 2 points for winning a game and 0 point for losing a game. The high score of the team get 2 points, and the low score team get 0 point.
- c) In any rare cases, such as a triple ko, when the contest ends in a no-win situation, there should be a replay between the two players immediately (the same rules apply as do the former) and the remaining time for the players is the duration of the replay.
- 7. Ranking method:
 - a) Children group: The children's group is ranked by the total score system. If the total score is the same, the ranking is divided according to the following order:
 - A. Compare the number of wins.
 - B. Compare the outcome of each other. (2 players only)
 - C. Compare the best opponent of the winning opponent in turn.
 - b) Youth group: Compare (1) total match points (2) total game point (3) sum of opponent's score (4) compare the winning rate of each stage in turn (5) compare the winning and losing of each teams (6) compare the direct comparison of each stage in turn (7) compare the ranking of all opponents.
- 8. Arbitration and appeal
 - a) The arbitrators and judges shall be appointed by the Chinese Weiqi Association.

- b) Set up arbitration commission.
- c) During the competition, if there is any dispute about the result of the match, the player shall appeal to the arbitration. The appeal fee is \$500. Within 120 minutes after the end of the game is the time for accepting the complaint, no more applications will be accepted after that time. If the complainants win, appeal fee will be returned in full, otherwise, appeal fee will not be returned and handed over to the Tournament Executive Committee for disposal.

II. Competition Instructions:

- 1. Applicant Eligibility: Each player must be an amateur Weiqi player.
 - a) A certified pro by a national or federal Go organization (including EGF and AGA) will not be eligible to this tournament.
 - b) The former pro (e.g. retired pro) will also not be eligible to the tournament.
 - c) The currently amateur player who will be either formally or informally approved or certified as a pro earlier than 1st August 2020 will not be eligible to this tournament.
- 2. Platform details will be announced soon.

- 3. Registration
 - a) Player is requested to return the following documents to the Tournament Executive Committee by <u>no later than 10 October</u> 2020.
 - i. Completed entry form (using the attached document)
 - ii. Face photo (*must be more than 100KB, good quality jpg color digital photo)
 - iii. Copy of passport (the page or pages clearly showing nationality)
 - iv. Proclamation
- 4. The Chinese Weiqi Association will provide each participating country with a competition fund of RMB 10,000 yuan for hiring supervisors.

- 5. The game time of each round is determined by the Tournament Executive Committee.
- 6. The results of the draw and the first-round pairings will be announced at 10:00 am (Beijing time) on October 26. After that, the pairings, game time and result of each round will be published through Facebook. Please follow the account number:
